This program provides:

- Paid internship for 20-40 hours/week at Water/Wastewater Agencies in the South Bay
- Assistance with transportation and safety equipment costs
- Post-internship job placement services & referrals to job openings with Bay Area agencies
- Referral to local apprenticeship and civil service testing opportunities

2. Eligible applicants with complete applications will receive a phone screening
3. Those who pass the phone screening will be invited to interview with employers

 - Automotive Technology
- Interest in water agency jobs
- Proof of Select Services registration (males only)
