- Have experience with machine care and maintenance.
- Learn from each project and apply that knowledge to future projects.

Machines most commonly used in our shop include: bandsaw, cold saw, mill, drill, manual lathe, TIG welder, belt sander, table saw, jointer, planer, hand sanders, hand chisels.

Regardless of experience, applicants need to be receptive to taking instruction and learning new processes and finishes. Knowledge of computer programs such as CAD, Rhino & Sketchup are beneficial but not essential.
