QUALIFICATIONS

- High-school diploma, GED, or equivalent, with completed shop math, mechanical drawing, or blueprint courses

- Basic knowledge and experience with equipment, tools, instruments, accessories, materials, processes, procedures
- Basic math skills, including geometry and trigonometry
- Ability to work in shop environment
- Valid CA driver's license, able to operate 6,000 lb. fork truck
- Medically qualified to wear respiratory and protection equipment
- Ability to pass drug test
- Ability to obtain DOE Q clearance
