Major Duties & Responsibilities:

- Responsible for quality parts produced on CNC machines such as but not limited to lathes & milling machines.
- Responsible for loading parts, proving tapes, operating controls, setting offsets, simple edits, debarring and inspection of quality parts for conformance to requirement.
- Studies & interprets drawings, manuals, specifications or sample parts to determine dimensions and tolerances of finished work pieces, sequence of operations and setup requirements.
- Measures and marks dimensions and reference points on material or work pieces as a guide for subsequent machining.
- Detect equipment malfunction or out of tolerance machining and adjusts machine, within capabilities, control or control media as required to ensure quality of production.
- Operates a forklift and lifting devices for movement of parts.
- Communicates with the team for assignments and resolve machining or quality issue.
- Responsible for keeping equipment and work area clean and orderly and perform basic preventative maintenance functions on equipment.
