STEAMFITTER

Monthly Salary Range: \$5,857 - \$6,457

THE POSITION

The Contra Costa County Public Works Department is currently recruiting to fill two **Steamfitter** vacant positions in Martinez CA. All interested and qualified individuals are encouraged to apply.

The Steamfitter classification perform at the journey level; including planning, layout and estimating job assignments and make recommendations on accomplishing the work. Work inspection and general supervision is received from the Lead Steamfitter and/or a General Services Facilities Supervisor. Although Steamfitters are assigned to the Public Works Department, some may be required to work in Probation, County Hospital and Detention Facilities buildings. Typical duties will include, repairing, maintaining and installing steam pumps, steam lines, hot water tanks and other auxiliary heating, cooling and refrigeration equipment. In addition this position will read and interpret or draw plans for installing new plumbing or heating equipment and estimate materials and labor costs.

The eligible list established from this recruitment will remain in effect for nine months.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Licenses Required: Possession of a valid California Motor Vehicle Operator's License. Out of State valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License will be accepted during the application process.

Experience: Either 1) Completion of an apprenticeship as a Steamfitter or Plumber and one (1) year of full-time or its equivalent experience as a journey level Steamfitter or Plumber or 2) Five (5) years of full-time or its equivalent plumbing or pipefitting experience in the plumbing or pipefitting industry, one (1) year of which was at the journey level.

SELECTION PROCESS

- 1. Application Filing:** All applicants, including County employees, are to apply on-line at www.cccounty.us/hr, and submit the required information as indicated on the job announcement by the final filing date listed above. All applicants must clearly demonstrate that they meet the minimum qualifications provided on the job announcement. Resumes may not be substituted for the official County application. **Paper, faxed, or late applications WILL NOT be accepted.** To view the typical tasks, knowledge, skills, and abilities associated with this position, please visit our website to see the detailed job description. - 2. Application Evaluation:** Depending on the number of applications received, an Application Evaluation Board may be convened to evaluate and select the best-qualified candidates for invitation to the next phase of the examination.
- 3. Oral Interview:** An oral interview will be conducted by a Qualifications Appraisal Board in Martinez, CA. The Board will evaluate candidates in job-related areas. Candidates must receive a rating of at least 70 from a majority of the Board members to be ranked on the employment list. **(Weighted 100%)**

As part of the application process, an applicant may be required to fill out a Conviction History form. Please note that the Conviction History Form should only be submitted when requested.

The Human Resources Department may change the examination steps noted above in accordance with the Personnel Management Regulations and accepted selection practices.
