This is a paid job opportunity for Electrical Worker II (EW IIs). EW IIs perform a variety of sub-journey level maintenance and repair, of electrical circuits, motors, controls used in large metropolitan water distribution and wastewater treatment facilities.

The most competitive candidates for this position will have:

- A solid understanding of hand and power tools used in electrical trade
- Mechanical ability and knowledge of arithmetic and mechanical principles
- Knowledge of National Electric Code and relevant Electrical Safety Orders
- Ability to read shop drawings and electrical diagrams

### CAREER PATH

The EW II position is a sub-journey level position toward the job of Electrical Technician which could promote to Electrical Supervisor, and further to Maintenance Superintendent. Promotion to each level in this career path requires successful completion of the application and exam process.

### HIRING PROCESS

All applicants who meet the job requirements will be invited to a two-step testing process. The first step is a technical oral exam. The second step is a hands-on performance test. Candidates successful in the testing process will be placed on a hiring list.

### JOB REQUIREMENTS

A high school diploma or its equivalent, and 12 months of experience equivalent to EBMUD's Electrical Worker I classification. EBMUD candidates must have achieved satisfactory completion of the OJT, vocational school, and self-study courses specified in the EBMUD's Maintenance Trades Program for Electrical Technicians, and upon supervisory certification of proficiency. Must advance to the Electrical Worker III within 18 months of appointment.

Completion of an accredited community college or comparable certificate program in electrical technology or closely related field, acceptable to EBMUD, may be substituted for the required 12 months of experience.

- Must possess a valid California driver's license and have a satisfactory driving record.
- Must possess the physical characteristics to perform the critical and important duties of the job
- Must be willing to work outdoors, in a variety of weather conditions, and work overtime as needed.
