We are looking for vehicle technicians to work on one of the most progressive vehicles in the world. He/she will be working in a manufacturing environment doing rework/repairs on vehicles either going through the production line or coming off the production line.

Responsibilities

- Performs work in the diagnosis, repair, and service of Tesla electric vehicles just manufactured in our Fremont factory.
- Performs diagnosis, and repair on electric power train systems, electrical systems, steering, suspension and even body work on newly manufactured Tesla Model S Sedans.
- Operate a variety of hand, power, and shop tools.
- Perform equipment inspections, adjustments and certifications.
- Maintain records of time and materials.
- Reports assembly and manufacturing anomalies requiring repeated repair.
- Order shop supplies and parts.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
- Knowledge of: Methods, techniques, parts, tools and materials used in the maintenance and repair of vehicles. Operation and maintenance of a wide variety of hand power tools, shop tools, and automotive and electrical test equipment.

Requirements
