- Checking and adjusting accuracy, including but not limited to using dial gages, test bars, grinding liners by horizontal grinding machines.
- Precisely assembling mechanical units or fabricated parts at floor stations or bench to make relatively large or heavy subassemblies or complete units using hand tools and light power tools and equipment
- Fitting, aligning, calibrating, and adjusting parts and mechanisms to meet tolerances and product operating requirements
- Repairing units, structures and products that fail to meet requirements
- Working as a team member, reporting to a Leader on assembly status
- Other duties as assigned

Minimum Requirements:

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- 3-5 years of relevant work experience
- Experience with precision machining assembly
- Ability to assemble spindles
- Must be able to lift up to 51 pounds, frequently stand, with repetitive bending, stooping and walking
- Ability to safely operate an overhead crane
- Fundamental computer operation skills: Microsoft Word, Excel, Outlook
- Preferred requirement certified operate a forklift
