- Collaborates with other maintenance staff on installations of mechanical and electro-mechanical equipment.
- Performs routine facility maintenance and facilities projects
- Performs janitorial maintenance and cleaning and minor building repairs as directed by the Maintenance Supervisor
- Maintains equipment, parts, and supply inventories by checking stock to determine inventory level; anticipating needed equipment, parts, and supplies; placing and expediting orders; verifying receipt
- Prepares and updates maintenance reports and logs
