Classes for high school students *

iDesign (1.5 units) – If you like to make things and want to learn how to machine and build things then iDesign-ST (Skilled Trades) is for you. This course offers one week in each of these skilled trades – Wood Technology, Machine Technology, & Carpentry. Design and create projects. Work in a lab. Make.

Create (2 units) – If you're a creator interested in exploring multiple media forms check this out. One week in each of these creative areas—Media, Graphic Arts, Photography, and IT. Completely hands on, project-based. Experience the intersection of human and computer image design and creation. Expand.

Electric Bike (3 units) – Learn the fundamentals of how electricity flows as you turn a bike into an electric ride. Theory and then hands on.

Sustainable Buildings of the Future (4 units) – Explore how buildings work and visit innovative buildings for special behind-the-scene tours. You'll meet professionals and hear about careers in architecture, mechanical engineering, and computerized building systems (aka building automation).

UPGRADE - Computer Science Education (6 units) – Learn about hardware and software principles as well as Raspberry Pi, HTML and Python in this class. You'll visit information and communications tech companies, plus find out about possible internships.

iEAT (2 units) – I eat, therefore I am! Explore food sciences doing hands on activities in culinary, chemistry, food technology / biomanufacturing and nutrition.
